

So, we THANK YOU again as we look forward to an even better 2014!





program highlights

Pass for Success offers the opportunity for fifth grade students from the AISD elementary schools to participate in a Football Passing Contest at the Cooper and Abilene High home football games. The students are selected from tryouts in their PE classes. They win \$200 for the PE department on their campus and receive an AEF Pass for Success t-shirt.

Award: \$3,000

The Judy Dudley GIFT (Giving to First-time Teachers) Grant is awarded to AISD employees who are teaching for the first time. Grant funds are for additional classroom materials to enhance those provided by the school district.

Award: \$10,300

STAR (Supporting Teachers with Academic Resources) Grants are awarded in September of each year for classroom projects that support curriculum and enrichment activities. STAR grants are used for a variety of classroom purposes from iPads to science laboratory skeletons. Over the course of the past eight cycles, AEF has given over \$350,000 in total grants to deserving and hard-working teachers.

Award: \$54,400

Young Masters Juried Art Exhibition provides an annual juried art exhibition at the Grace Museum for Advanced Placement Studio Art students to recognize and encourage outstanding artistic expression with a quality museum exhibition.

Award: \$8,500

TLC (Teachers in the Limelight Celebration) honors the dedicated work of teachers in AISD with campus recognition, a formal dinner, and a monetary award. A TLC teacher possesses integrity and a love for teaching that spills into the classroom. Awards are funded by the Edwin and Agnes Jennings Sr. Teaching Excellence Endowment.

Award: \$13,800

ACT (Achievement, Creativity and Technology) Grants respond to requests from AISD educators and non-profits for the purpose of improving achievement or rewarding academic achievement related to the education of AISD students. These grants are awarded in three cycles during the school year.

Award: \$18,900

COOL (College Offers Opportunities for Life) Program places four full-time college advisors in Abilene ISD schools to assist students who are first in their families to attend college. Advisors assist with college applications, scholarships, applying for financial aid, college tours, and college educational presentations to elementary and middle school students. Expenses: \$300,000

AEF Scholarships strive to reward outstanding students of AISD with scholarships in an effort to make the transition from high school to college as seamless as possible and to avoid huge post-graduation debt. In 2013, AEF gave away \$54,000 in scholarships! Scholarships granted in 2013 include Abilene Education Foundation, AHS and CHS Alumni, and individual donor directed. Additional donor scholarships include the Johnny Ortega Jr. Memorial, AISD Transportation, School Nutrition Association of Abilene, Citizens Bank of Abilene, Abernathy, Young Masters, the BreLex Memorial, and the Meta Alice Keith Bratten Foundation.

Award: \$54,000

fundraising successes

Cajun Fest

The Third Annual Cajun Fest event in conjunction with Art Walk (sponsored by the Center for Contemporary Arts) launched last April with generous support from numerous businesses and individuals. AEF organized a feast of crawfish and shrimp as well as highlighted talented students of AISD. Student performances included AHS Steel Drum Band, CHS Red Rhythm and Blues, Dyess Elementary 2nd graders, Revolution, CHS and AHS dance teams, and cheerleaders. Kindergarten through 3rd grade students from all campuses participated in a coloring contest and named the Shrimp Boat Captain. Volunteers ranged from Abilene and Cooper High ROTC, Boys Scouts of Abilene, community members, Dyess personnel, to AHS and CHS Alumni. The event proved to be a huge success and netted over \$50,000 in revenue which was used to help support the teachers and students of AISD, including scholarships to students.

Annual Fund

Every fall, in an effort to raise unrestricted and restricted funds, the AEF Board of Directors sends out a letter to previous and potential donors thanking them for their support. In 2013, the Annual Fund campaign raised \$49,200 in unrestricted monies and \$48,900 in restricted funds.

Abilene ISD Payroll Deduction Campaign

The Payroll Deduction Campaign gives employees of Abilene ISD the opportunity to directly support STAR Teacher Grants, or any other AEF program through payroll deduction. Under the direction of board member and chair Kaye Price-Hawkins, donations to the employee payroll deduction campaign have increased

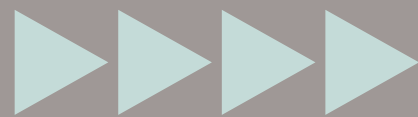
approximately 260% since its inception in 2008. This has allowed AEF to give away more money each and every year to STAR Teacher Grants. Employees may also specify their donation go to another AEF program. In the fall of 2013, employees of AHS, CHS, and ATEMS began a scholarship fund for a deserving senior at their school. Another reason the payroll deduction campaign has grown is due to the hard work of our campus liaisons who serve as spokespersons on behalf of AEF during their campus staff meetings. 100% of all funds raised through the payroll deduction campaign go directly into the hands of the teachers and students in Abilene ISD. This year campuses who reached 80%, 90% or 100% participation received campus rewards. They include Abilene High, Austin, Bowie, Bonham, Holland, Jackson, Lee, Long, the Planetarium, Taylor, and Thomas. All employees who signed up for the campaign were entered into a drawing to win one of ten 32" flat screen TVs donated by Aaron's Electronics.

Online Auction

AEF held its first online auction in the fall of 2013. AISD helped AEF with items to be auctioned such as an opportunity to stand on the sideline at the CHS and AHS football games, opportunity to lead both high school bands in the fight song, help broadcast games with the radio announcers, and many more. Encore Grillers offered a tail gate party that was available prior to the AHS/CHS rivalry game. Bidders logged on the AEF website at www.aaceff.org and were able to view the items available and bid on their choice. We look forward to having another auction in the spring. If these prove successful, we hope to have one each fall and spring to generate funds that will support our programs.

The Royce Curtis Excellence in Education Endowed Scholarship Fund

During their 20th class reunion, the AHS Class of 1993 announced, to a very much surprised Royce Curtis, their involvement in the startup of an endowed scholarship fund which will help future college-bound Eagles. Royce served the students of Abilene for 35 years. Fourteen of those years were at Abilene High as Principal and seven as the AISD Associate Superintendent of Personnel. Many students from the Class of 1993 had Mr. Curtis as a principal beginning in the sixth grade at Franklin Middle School.

The \$25,000 endowment was established by AHS '93 graduate Dr. Bracken Kollé and his wife, Joana. Dr. Kollé, who was also valedictorian of his class, has committed to match additional pledges and donations to the endowment up to an additional \$25,000. Royce Curtis was the principal of Abilene High School from 1989 until 2003. He possesses the Eagle spirit and a love for seeing his students succeed. Interest earned from the endowment honors his legacy at Abilene High by awarding a deserving college-bound senior with a scholarship. The first annual Royce Curtis Excellence in Education Endowed Scholarship will

LEGACY DONORS AND ADDITIONAL ENDOWMENT FUNDS

Mike Dudley announced his Legacy Gift in November of 2013 with the bequest of 401K and stocks. He has also established a bank account that will provide checks payable to AEF for the GIFT Grant Program.

In 2011 Mindy Morris, AISD employee, photographer, and long-time AEF enthusiast, became our first Legacy Donor by including AEF in her estate planning. She takes pictures with the Prize Parade of STAR Teacher Grant winners. By including AEF in her estate, she leaves a lasting legacy of education for future AISD students.

In 2005, Julia Jones Matthews established an endowment benefitting Abilene Education Foundation at the Community Foundation of Abilene. The corpus of that endowment is owned and managed by Community Foundation. Interest earned helps with AEF's operational expenses.
JJM: Corpus \$500,000

Abilene Education Foundation has established a second endowment fund also managed by the Community Foundation of Abilene. This endowment, initially established with generous contributions from Lee and Ruth Caldwell, continues to grow and support AEF programs.
AEF Endowment: \$42,000

In 2009, former Abilene High School and Cooper High School alumni helped to establish the groundwork for two

additional endowments to provide scholarships for AHS and CHS graduates. Abilene Education Foundation is working with donors and class reunions to grow these endowments so that scholarships can be awarded every year to Cooper and Abilene High graduates.
AHS Endowment: \$27,000
CHS Endowment: \$26,000

With the donation of 3,000 shares of Exxon Mobile stock from Mr. Edwin Jennings, Jr. a permanent endowment held at the Community Foundation of Abilene has been established to honor teachers making a difference in the lives of students in Abilene ISD. This endowment will allow AEF to continue these awards yearly for generations to come as part of TLC (Teacher in the Limelight Celebration).
TLC: Corpus \$275,000

The Martha Louise Scott Carlson Fund for AEF GIFT Grants Endowment

Martha grew up in Waxahachie, Texas, and was a graduate of North Texas State College. While at North Texas State, she was president of her college sorority, president of a club council, and a member of an honorary business club. Upon graduation, she taught school in Midland before marrying Roy Carlson in 1952. She was a homemaker, mother, Bible student, faithful friend to many, and loving family member.

Martha was a sweet gracious lady whose joy of friends and family never left her and neither did her love for education. Martha was a wonderful friend, cherishing and helping those around her wherever she lived. While in Abilene, she donated funds to AEF to begin the GIFT Grant program. She provided donations through AEF to have a security officer present at the AISD School Board meetings and funded needs in the deaf education classroom at Ward Elementary.

In her memory her family, including her daughter, Laura Dyer, who presently serves as an AISD School Board Trustee, established a \$25,000 endowment held at the Community Foundation of Abilene to continue to support the GIFT (Giving to First-time Teachers) Grant each year with funds to help first-year, new-to-the-profession teachers outfit their classrooms. What an amazing tribute and honor given in memory of this past teacher and truly giving individual!

Judy was a long time teacher at Fannin Elementary who loved her students and understood the importance of creating an inviting classroom for children to learn and grow. Mike also gives STAR Teacher Grants in Judy's memory funded through the Community Foundation of Abilene. Both Mike and Judy Dudley dedicated their professional lives to the betterment of students in Abilene ISD. By becoming a Legacy Donor, Mike and Judy's passion for educating the students in Abilene will flourish, truly making a difference for years to come.

donor spotlight: leaving a legacy

MR. EDWIN J. JENNINGS, JR.

Mr. Edwin Jennings, Jr. was born in Abilene in 1922 to Edwin J. Jennings, Sr. and Agnes May Smith. He attended Alta Vista Elementary, Central School, and graduated from Abilene High School in 1940. He was a member of the Abilene High School Boys Band, winner of the math award, and valedictorian of his class.

Mr. Jennings spent his professional career in chemistry; he is also a natural-born teacher who spent hours tutoring the football team while attending Rice Institute in the late 1940's.

In 2012 with the donation of 3,000 shares of Exxon Mobil stock from Mr. Jennings, AEF established the Edwin and Agnes Jennings Teaching Excellence Award Endowment in memory of Mr. Jennings' parents to honor teachers making a difference in the lives of students in Abilene ISD. In April of 2013, AEF held the first TLC (Teacher in the Limelight Celebration) event at which outstanding teachers in AISD were recognized, honored, and received monetary awards. Twenty-nine teachers were awarded
